NORTON BAVANT, a township and parish in the Hundred and Union of Warminster, South Wilts, 3 miles south-east from Warminster station, 117 from London, and 1 north-west from Heytesbury. The living is a vicarage, value £150, in the archdeaconry and diocese of Salisbury, and in the patronage of the Crown; the Rev. Edward Eliot, M. A., is the present incumbent. The church is dedicated to All Saints. Population, in 1851, 284; area in acres, 2,161; and rateable value, £2,477.
