NORTON COLEPARLE, a small village and parish, situated on the lower Avon, 4 miles south-west from Malmesbury, and about 8 north-west from Chippenham, in the Hundred and Union of Malmesbury, Cricklade parliamentary borough, North Wilts. The living is a vicarage, in the diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, and the gift of Joseph Neeld, Esq., who is lord of this manor; the Rev. John Edward Jackson is the incumbent. The parish church is small, and of considerable antiquity. The area is I,050 in acres, and the population 123.
