On Friday, a labourer, named Thomas Weeks, living at Nunton, was cutting down with a reap hook some nettles that were growing near several bee hives. The bees attacked him and, in endeavouring to keep them away, he struck his head with the reap hook producing a severe scalp wound and rendering it necessary to remove him to the Salisbury Infirmary.
