1812

On Monday Joseph Francis was committed to Fisherton Gaol, for trial at the next Assizes, charged with having stolen two bushels of wheat, the property of Mr. Thomas Attwater, of Nunton. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 15 June 1812**

1831

Committed to Fisherton Gaol: John Whitmarsh, charged with having, on the 17th inst, stolen a silver watch, the property of Donat Richards, at the parish of Nunton and Bodenham. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 21 March 1831
