

Nunton & Bodenham 1800- 1849

1805

On Thursday last was married, at Nunton, in the parish of Downton, by the Rev. Mr. Daishwood, Mr. James Rogers, son of Mrs. Mary Rogers of Week Farm, to Miss Fanstone, only daughter of Mr. H. Fanstone, upholsterer, of Downton. **Salisbury & Winchester Journal, 28 October 1805**

1818

On Wednesday last died Mr. William Attwater, of Bodenham, near this city. By his death his nearest relatives have met with an irreparable loss. From his hospitality and sociable disposition he had gained the respect and esteem of a large circle of friends, all of whom most sincerely deplore the awful event. His days of nature were as an agreeable tale that is soon told, - not tedious, trifling, idle or insignificant; but short, instructive, moral and entertaining.
