Inquest on Charles Lee

Inquests taken before Mr. Whitmarsh

At Ogbourn St. George, on the body of Charles Lee, 38 years of age, who was late of the 76th Regiment of Foot, and since an out-pensioner of Her Majesty's Royal Hospital at Chelsea.

Deceased was found nearly lifeless in bed from a rupture of a blood-vessel in the chest, and a verdict was returned accordingly.
