

ACCIDENTS Pewsey 1800-1899

1867

On Wednesday last, as Mr. William Berry, of Ludgershall, was returning home from the parade of the Devizes Troop, which took place on the previous day, the horse which he was riding took fright when near Pewsey, at some disarrangement of its trappings, and after running a short distance at racing speed, swerved and fell over a bank by the roadside, falling on its rider, who, however, luckily escaped with a broken head and a few severe bruises.
