Translated it reads

In the name of God this is the testament of King Eldred, which is to be performed. Firstly, he leaves to the place in which it pleases him to rest after his death two golden crosses with golden images, and two swords, with golden hilts, and four hundred pounds. Also he bequeaths to the old monastery of Winchester three towns which are Downton, Damerham and Calne.

The testament ends.

...... And I will that this testament shall remain immutably as long as Christianity shall endure in consideration of the divine love for the salvation of my soul Amen
