1831

April 18 1831 At Stanton, the Rev Edward Rowden, Vicar of Highworth, Wilts to Ellen Frances, eldest daughter of the Rev. Dr. Ashfordby Trenchard, of Stanton House. **Gentleman's Magazine, April 183, Page 635**

1838

March 10. Aged 66, the Rev John Ashfordby Trenchard DCL of Stanton House, Wilts and Rector of Stanton Fitzwarren. He was born at Chestnut, the son of John Ashfordby, of Stanton Fitzwarren Esq and assumed the name of Trenchard after his own. He was admitted a Commoner of Trinity College, Oxford in 1789 and graduated B and DCL 1802.
