Promoted to Captain whilst on active service

24th November 1899 until 10th June 1900 served in South Africa at the Relief of Ladysmith 17th October 1899 unt1l 24th January 1900 and at Spion Kop from 5th to 7th February 1900 including action at Vaal Krantz. Also involved in operations at Tugela from the 14th - 27th February 1900 and action at Pieters Hill. Also operational in Natal in March 1900.

11th June 1900 to 15th January 1902 returned to home service

16th January 1902 to 19th October 1902 served in South Africa

Awarded the Queens South African Medal with Clasp for Boer War Service

20th October 1902 to 2nd October 1906; Commanded 31st Company M.I. at Bulford Camp from 1st January 1906 to 2nd April 1906

3rd October 1906 to 18th April 1908 served in India, passing Hindustani fluency exam on 1sy July 1907

A notice of promotion to Temporary Staff Captain was announced in the London Gazette in 1914

Promoted to Major

Had a period of sickness from 19th April 1908 to 22 January 1910

Retired from Military Service on the 2nd April 1913

Other Significant Information

Educated at Winchester College

Fluent in French, German, Italian and Hindustani

In 1912 - 1913 Edward Shirley was living in Officers' Quarters in St. Peters, Dorchester, Dorset

In the December Quarter of 1921 a marriage was registered in the Chelsea Registration District between Edward S. Godman and Isabella M. Annesley; The marriage took place on 15th November 1921 in St. Luke Church, Chelsea

A daughter Isabel Hope Godman was born on 31st January 1923 in Exeter, Devon. She died in 1978. In the 1939 Register she was away from home at boarding school,

A son Desmond F. S. Godman was born in 1927 in Wincanton, Somerset (Probably the Closed entry in the 1939 Register).

In 1928 - Edward and his wife Isabella Myrtle were resident in St. Martins. Gillingham, Dorset


Edward Shirley of Chetcombe House, Mere, left a will. Probate was granted in the Probate Court in London on 15th June 1951 to Isabel Myrtle Godman. Widow; Desmond Frederick Shirley Godman, Agricultural Student; and Nigel William Ivo Naper, Farmer. Estate Value being £11643 8s. 10d.

His widow Isabel Myrtle was living in Nutborne Duntisbourne, Cirencester at the time of her death which was registered in the March Quarter of 1978 in the Swindon Registration District.

At the time of writing we have been unable to locate a burial location for Edward nor his wife Isabel. It is of course possible that the couple were cremated but we have no firm evidence of this. We have been unsuccessful in tracing obituaries in the local newspapers either.
