STRATFORD TONEY, or STRATFORD ST. ANTHONY, a township and parish in Cawden and Cadworth Hundred, Alderbury Union, South Wilts, and Wilton parliamentary borough, 4 miles south-west from Salisbury, is pleasantly situated on a branch of the River Avon. The living is a rectory, in the archdeaconry and diocese of Salisbury, valued in the King's Books at £12, and in the patronage of Corpus Christi College, Oxford. The church is dedicated to St. Lawrence. Population, in 1851, 165, with 1,173 acres.
