## *Hippenscombe, Tidcombe 1850-1899*

**1861**

Everley Petty Sessions, Friday February 22 Before T.E. Fowle, Esq., and Major Heathcote.  
Charles Gilbert, under carter in the employ of Mr Charles Miles, of Hippenscombe, was brought up under a warrant, charged with absconding from his master's service, on the 8th inst. Defendant assigned as his reason for leaving that "the other carters were down upon him." He was ordered to pay 5s and costs, to forfeit a fortnight's wages, and to return to his work forthwith. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 2 March 1861**
