Rose Ellen & Ida Kathleen Hulbert

Rose Ellen Farr's birth was registered in March quarter 1865 in the district of Melksham, Wiltshire. Her parents were Alfred & Mary Farr (nee Davis).

Rose Ellen Farr married Alfred William Hulbert in 1884 at Trowbridge Register Office.

The 1891 England Census recorded Alfred (Steam Engine Driver, aged 27) & Ellen (aged 26) living at No. 29 Upton Lovell, Wiltshire. They had 4 children listed on this Census – Florence (aged 6, born Trowbridge), Bessie (aged 5, born Trowbridge). Alice (aged 2, born Upton Lovell) & Lilie (aged 1 month, born Upton Lovell).

A birth was registered in September quarter 1896 in the district of Warminster, Wiltshire for Ida Kathleen Hulbert. Her parents were Alfred William & Rose Ellen Hulbert (nee Farr).

The 1901 England Census recorded Ida Hulbert as a 4 year old living with her family at High Street, Upton Lovell, Wiltshire. Her parents were recorded as Alfred W. Hulbert (Millwright, aged 37, born Trowbridge) & Rose E. Hulbert (aged 35, born Trowbridge. Ida was the youngest of 3 children listed in this census with all 3 children being born at Upton Lovell, Wiltshire – Lily (aged 10), Edith M. (aged 7) then Ida.

A death for Alfred William Hulbert, aged 37, was registered in December quarter, 1901 in the district of Warminster. Probate details – Hulbert, Alfred William of Upton Lovell, Wiltshire, General Dealer died 5 October, 1901. Probate – Salisbury 10 January, 1902 to Alfred James Bartlett, builder. Effects £316 7s. 2d.

Ellen Hulbert & her daughter Kathleen were listed as passengers on the *Ivernia* which had departed from Liverpool, England & arrived at the port of Boston, Massachusetts on 5 May, 1910. Ellen was intending to travel to Providence, Rhode Island to her Uncle's place.

Rose Ellen Farr Hulbert, aged 45, married Robert Stansfield, aged 63, at Attlebro, Massachusetts, USA on 27th July, 1910 by Justice of Peace. Robert Stansfield, who was born in England, was a Machinist & this was his fourth marriage.

The 1920 United States Federal Census recorded Robert (aged 72) & Ellen Stansfield (aged 52) living at 233 Admiral Street, Providence, Rhode Island. They had a boarder living with them – James McDougal (Case Maker, aged 31, born Nova Scotia). Robert & Ellen did not have occupations.

Ida Kathleen Hulbert married James Ashworth at Providence, Rhode Island, USA on 25th August, 1928 at the age of 31.
