Upton Lovell

The work of restoring the ancient and interesting little church of Upton Lovell has just been commenced by Messrs. Adlam and Strong, of Warminster, under the direction of Mr Ponting, diocesan architect and surveyor. The exterior of the fabric is in a fairly good state of repair, and it is therefore to the interior of the sacred edifice that special attention is to be given. The total cost of the work will be about £600, and of this amount nearly three-fourths has been received.
