November 14, at Upton Lovell, Wilts, by the Rev. W. Gray, Louisa, eldest daughter of Mr. Thomas Raxworthy, to Henry Charles, only son of Mr. William Burt, Whitchampton, Dorset. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 21 November 1850**

**1853**

On the 25th ultimate, at Heytesbury, Arthur, second son of Mr. Job Bartlett, of Upton Lovell, to Betsey, youngest daughter of Mr. Robert Whatley, of Heytesbury. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 7 May 1853**

Died On the 27th ultimate, of diarrhea, on board the Arabia, on his way from Balaklava to hospital at Scutari, William Gray, of the 1st Royal Dragoons, second son of the Rev. William Gray, Rector of Upton Lovell, aged 20. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 24 February 1855**

June 7, at Upton Lovell, Wilts, Mr. Thomas Searchfield, of Heytesbury, to Emily, second daughter of Mr. John Hinton of Upton. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 14 June 1855**

On the 16th instant, at Upton Lovell, by the Rev. W. Gray, Mr. R. E. Thorn, eldest son of Mr. J. Thorn, of Leydon House, Christchurch Road, Streatham, Surrey, to Fanny, third daughter of Mr. Raxworthy, of Upton Lovell. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 20 October 1855**

Died On the 12th instant, of decline, in London, Caroline, the beloved wife of Mr. William Fryer, and daughter of the late Mr. Smith, of Upton Lovell, Wilts, deeply lamented by all who knew her, aged 32 years. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 17 November 1855**

Died On the 17th instant, at Corton, after a lingering illness, in the 32nd year of his age, Simon, youngest son of the late Mr. James Smith, yeoman, of Upton Lovell, Wilts. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 25 October 1856**

**1858**

Died December 2, at Upton Lovell, Mr. William Titt, aged 44 years. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 9 December 1858**

**1859**

Died On the 28th ultimate, at Upton Lovell, at the advanced age of 84, Ann, widow of Mr. Thomas Mogg. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 2 July 1859**

On the 1st instant, at Durrington, by the Rev. W. Webb, the Rector, Mr. Thomas Costan, the only son of Mr. Thomas Costan, of Banbury, Oxfordshire, to Matilda, second daughter of Mr. James Dyer, postmaster, of Upton Lovell, Wilts. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 6 August, 1859**

**1860**

Died On the 24th instant, suddenly, at Upton Lovell, aged 22, Clara, fourth daughter of Mr. Raxworthy. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 29 December 1860**

**1861**

Died December 24, suddenly, at Upton Lovell, aged 23, Clara, fourth daughter of Mr. Raxworthy. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 3 January 1861**

May 15, at Upton Lovell, by the Rev. W. Gray, Mr. John Raxworthy, of Codford St. Peter, to Fanny Thorn, third daughter of Mr. Raxworthy, of the above place. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 23 May 1861**

Died On the 15th instant, at Upton Lovell, Miss Rowden. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 25 May 1861**

Died On the 22nd instant at Upton Lovell, Wilts, after a short illness, in the 5th year of his age, the only and beloved son of Mr. James Gibbs, corporal in the Royal Marine Artillery. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 27 July, 1861**

On the 17th instant, at Upton Lovell, by the Rev. William Gray, Ann, the youngest daughter of the late Sergeant Olivear, to Mr. Thomas Hurle, of Heytesbury, Sergeant in the 6th Regiment of Foot. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 23 November 1861**

**1866**

On the 20th instant, at Upton Lovell, by the Rev. William Gray, Samuel Secombe, esq., of Liskeard, to Henrietta Smith, youngest daughter of the late St. John Hewitt, esq., of Sudden Park Farm, Great Bedwin, Wilts. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 27 September 1866**

**1868**

On the 28th ultimate, the wife of Mr. Henry S. Hewitt, Upton Lovell, of a daughter. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 3 June 1871**

**1872**

Died On the 9th instant, after a long illness, in the 84th year of her age, at the residence of her son, Mr. Sidney Smith, Worcester, Susannah, widow of the late Mr. James Smith, Upton Lovell, Wilts. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 17 August 1872**

**1874**

Died September 15, at the Rectory, Upton Lovell, Wilts, the Rev. William Gray, for 32 years rector of Upton Lovell, in his 78th year. **Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 24 September 1874**

**1888**

October 24, at the parish church, Upton Lovell, Wilts, Harry Pinchin, second son of the late Harry Pinchin, of Monckton Combe, to Rhoda, eldest daughter of Harry Fry, of Upton Lovell. **Devizes and Wiltshire Gazette, Thursday, 1 November 1888**

**1892**

July 17, at Upton Lovell, the wife of R. J. H. Coles, a daughter. **Wiltshire Times, Saturday, 30 July 1892**

**1898**

Died On the 11th May at Upton Lovell Rectory, Bath, England, Mira, wife of the Rev. H. E. Windle, rector, and only daughter of the late Thomas Bates, of Lara, aged 80. **The Argus, Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, Tuesday, 28 June 1898**
