Boundary Post

On South side of Drive to Guernsey Farm

Upton Lovell, Wiltshire

Grade II - Listed 11th December, 1987

Boundary post. Circa 1840.

Cast iron T-shaped post with low pedimented top and raised lettering to front:

KNOOK on right hand arm and UPTON LOVELL on left hand.

One of a series of boundary posts and mileposts made by the Warminster iron founders, Carson and Miller.
