Rev. Charles Herbert Young B.D.

News has been received in Launceston of the death at his residence Boreham-road, Warminster, England of Rev. Charles Herbert Young, B.D., aged 84 years.

Born in Kent he was brought to Australia by his parents when a child, and it was in Australia that he did the greater part of his clerical work. His first curacy was in Launceston, and afterwards he held many livings in different parts of Australia.

He returned to England in 1914, and for 12 years was rector of Northstoke, near Bath. When he retired in 1936 he retired to Warminster. A Freemason, he joined the Longleaf Lodge, Warminster, in 1929, and also belonged to the Rosa Crucian degree.

In recent years he did temporary duty in many of the churches in the Warminster district, notably at Upton Lovell. He was a regular worshipper at St. John's Church, Warminster.
