Upton Lovell



Upton Lovell is a small village on the banks of the Wiley, in the Hundred of Heytesbury and Warminster Union, distant 6 miles south-east from Warminster and 1 ½ south-east-by-south from Heytesbury. The living is a rectory, value £325, in the patronage of the Crown; the Rev. William Gray is the present incumbent.

Here is a small Free School. Joseph Everett, Esq., is lord of the manor.

Population, in 1841, 235; area in acres, 1,387.
