Village Pub Sold

A 19th century pub in the Wylye Valley near Warminster has been sold.

The Prince Leopold Inn in Upton Lovell, which dates back to 1887 and was originally a village shop, post office and general store, has been sold to Nash Keshwala, from Hounslow in Middlesex.

Current owners Graham and Pamela Waldren-Bradley, who have been at the helm for eight years, are retiring and planning a trip around the Greek islands on their 40-foot yacht.

The pub was sold for an undisclosed fee after vendors Christie and Co put the freehold on the market for £680,000.
