

## Hog roast help for Wiltshire's

A hog roast feast held by the Wiltshire Air Ambulance Appeal at Manor Farm, Upton Lovell, raised £4,500 for the charity.

Last year the air ambulance crew flew 428 missions across the county, saving numerous lives.

It needs £350,000 funding every year and receives no financial support from the Government.

The Air Ambulance can take the seriously injured to the most appropriate treatment centre, quickly and safely and it can reach any part of Wiltshire within 10 minutes.

It can reach any major trauma centre within 15 minutes.

Tracey Edwards, fundraising Coordinator said: "We would like to pass on our sincere thanks to the organisers and all who attended the hog roast who gave the appeal such tremendous support.

"We are entirely dependent upon the goodwill of the public to raise the £350,000 needed each year."
