



Coroners Inquest Reports

Westbury

Inquest held by George Sylvester, esq. –

At Westbury, on James Hulbert, aged 39 years. The deceased was working in the interior of the Church, and the scaffolding giving way, he fell to the aisle a height of 18 or 19 feet, causing a commuted fracture of the right collar-bone and concussion of the brain, of which he died in four hours. Verdict – Accidentally Killed.
