Uffler	Bargeman who assists in towing
Ulnager	Alnager; Aulnager; Sworn officer to examine and attest measurement and quality of woolen goods
Unbelieving	Disobedient; Naughty
Underletter	Tenant who sub lets property
Undersettle	Sub-tenant of smallholding
Undertaker	One who rented Crown land in Ireland; Professional burial and funeral arranger.
Up-along	A short distance up the road
Upholder	Upholsterer; Supplier or maker of furniture; Undertaker; Cheap second hand dealer
Upholsterer	House furnisher; One who covers furniture with various kinds of textiles
Upping-stock	Block for aiding someone to mount a horse
Urinator	Diver
Usager	One who has the use of anything in trust for another; Executor of a will; Trustee of a deceased person's estate
