Mr. Vivian Carter gave the second of his series of war commentaries to a crowded audience at the town Hall on Monday evening. The chair was taken by the Constable (Mr. W. S. Raine). Should it fall there would still be plenty of Russian resistance if necessary, by retreat into Northern Asia.
