Also I give to my wife Ann all the rest and residue of my estate and effects to be enjoyed by her during so long time as she shall continue my widow and unmarried And my will is if my said wife shall marry any second husband that then and immediately after such marriage I do give one moiety or half part of my estate and effects to be equally divided to and between John the son of Joseph Stancomb of Trowbridge, cloth worker, and to Sarah the daughter of John House of Keevil be to be equally divided between them share and share alike to be freely had taken and enjoyed by them or the value thereof in money being half the total value of my estate.

And I desire an inventory may be taken soon after my decease and that the said John Stancomb and Sarah House may have copies of the inventory and I do make my said wife Ann Kingman sole executrix of this my last will and testament.
